

IN JESUS' FOOTSTEPS WE FOLLOW

William Broders in his book *Handyman of the Lord*, tells the story about a poor man who was begging for food. He rang the front doorbell of a mansion and was told to go around the back where he would be given something to eat.

The owner of the mansion met the poor man on the back porch and said to him, "First we will bless the food. Repeat after me. Our Father who art in Heaven ..."

The poor man replied, "Your Father who art in heaven ..."

"No", the owner of the house corrected. "Our Father who art in heaven."

The poor man replied: "Yes sir, but if I say 'Our Father', that would make you and me brothers, and I am afraid the Lord wouldn't like you askin' your brother to come to the back porch to get a piece of bread."

It is not always easy to put into actions the words that we say in our prayers. It's as difficult as bringing our faith from inside the church and out into the street. In one of his reflections during angelus time, Pope Francis said: "Prayer that doesn't lead to concrete action toward our brothers is a fruitless and incomplete prayer, but at the same time, when ecclesial service only attends to work, not reserving time for dialogue with God in prayer, it risks serving itself rather than God who is present in the brother in need. Prayer and action must always be profoundly united."

In today's gospel, Jesus gives special instructions to his disciples on how to be his true disciples. It demands great commitment. Jesus is challenging them to be more serious in their decision to follow him. He says: "Anyone who prefers father or mother to me is not worthy of me. Anyone who prefers son or daughter to me is not worthy of me. Anyone who does not take his cross and follow in my footsteps is not worthy of me."

To follow Jesus means to imitate Jesus and to love in the way he loves. Jesus' love is universal. He doesn't limit his love just to his family because, for Jesus, family means not only those who are connected to him biologically. He once said: "Here are my mothers and my brothers. For whoever does the will of my Father in heaven is my brother and sister and mother."

Jesus wants his disciples to follow his footsteps and to spread the love of God to as many people as possible. As Jesus followers, we are challenged to renew our commitment and our relationship with him.

We need to put our faith into actions by being kind to our brothers and sisters in need.

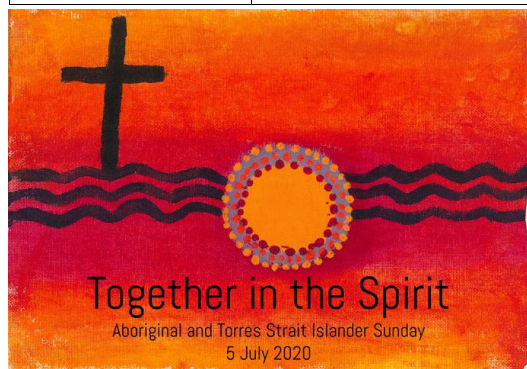

Dear Parishioners,

I am happy to advise that as of Saturday, 27th June the covid-19 restrictions will be further relaxed and you are now able to attend mass without registering. You still need to follow the social distancing rule of 1.5 metres from other households and to use the hand sanitiser provided before entering and leaving the Church as required per Government Directives. You will still be required to sit within the designated lines on the pews except where people from the same household may sit together.

Persons who feel unwell, who have flu/respiratory symptoms, elevated body temperatures or who have been in contact with persons suspected to have, or who have been diagnosed with COVID-19, are not permitted to enter the church.

Parish Planned Giving Program

The renewal of our Planned Giving Program is held in June each year. This year though, with the Covid-19 restrictions, I am reaching out to you with this notice. It is because of your continued generosity that we have been able to start the building program for our new offices and the extension of the church foyer. The second collection is for the parish to be able function and meet its day to day demands. I would like to invite you to confirm your commitment and/or join our Planned Giving Program so our parish may continue to operate, function, grow and improve.

Envelope System

For new parishioners and contributors wanting to donate through the envelope system you will need to complete a planned giving commitment card. For all our current contributors who would like to continue with the envelope system, your envelopes are now available to be picked up in the church foyer. If any of your contact details have changed or you would like to change the amount or frequency of contributions, you must complete a Planned Giving Commitment Card, phone or email the parish office.

Direct Debit System

We encourage you to consider making your contribution through our direct debit system. This simplifies the work that is required and also gives greater security of our collections. Direct debit request forms will be available in the church foyer and the parish office and must be completed and signed. Those with direct debit already in place will only need to fill out a new direct debit request form if they want to change the amount or frequency of their donation. We need a signed form as we do not have the authority to change either of these without it.

All planned giving cards and direct debit request forms must be given to Fr Philip or handed into the parish office so they may be entered onto our system.

Parish office hours are 9am to 1.30pm Tuesday to Friday.
